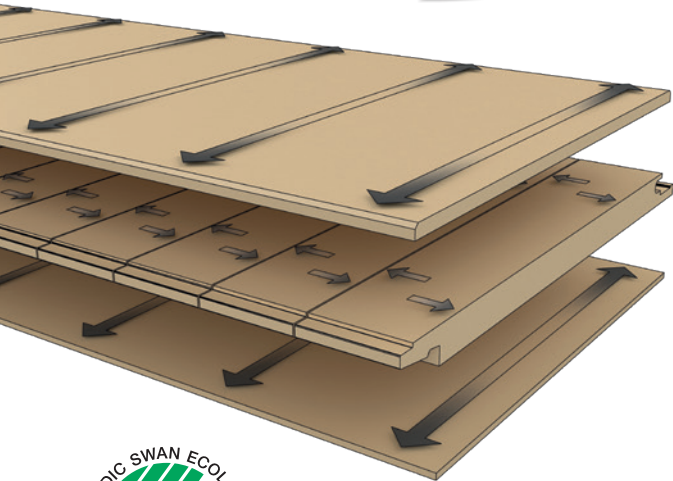

Pergo wood floors consist of 3 layers of wood with the grain running in different directions to reduce the natural expansion and shrinking caused by fluctuations in temperature and humidity. An advanced core of hevea absorbs stress and strain to ensure that your floor remains stable in almost all conditions.



1 Protective finish

7 layers of high quality lacquer provide maximum wear and scratch protection and ensure easy maintenance.

2 Face layer

A carefully selected wood layer, nominal 3 mm, that can be sanded 2 – 3 times.

3 Advanced core

The core absorbs the stresses and strains that are put on your floor, and ensures that it remains stable in all conditions.

4 Balanced backing

The backing veneer is made from ecologically certified wood and helps to perfectly balance the boards.

Warranty

Thanks to a robust and innovative construction, every Pergo wooden floor is made to last, and that's why our products come with an extensive warranty.

» All floors have a **33 year structural warranty.**

» And a **10 year StayClean, moisture protection, warranty.**

Select grade

All Pergo Gotland floors use selected grading. This exclusive grading reduces colour and grain variation, and allows only smaller knots. Only the finest 10% of Oak lumber is used for a tailored and minimalist look.



2-way bevel

Bevels define each individual plank, creating the feeling of an authentic wood floor. Our collection features designs with bevels on the longest sides of the plank.



Brushed structure

Brushing the surface of a wood plank accentuates the natural grain structure and enhances the authentic look and feel of the wood.



Matt lacquer finish

The matt finish makes for a lower maintenance floor surface and provides lower visibility of minor damage or indentations that may occur from time to time. The subtlety of Pergo matt finish allows other furniture and interior components space to shine.



To ensure that you may enjoy your floors for many years to come, our floors are given a protective and caring surface finish against wear and scratches. All our floors are ready for use right out of the box, with no extra surface treatment necessary. Our lacquers meet strict international emission norms, so you can enjoy your wood flooring knowing that it was made with respect for the environment.

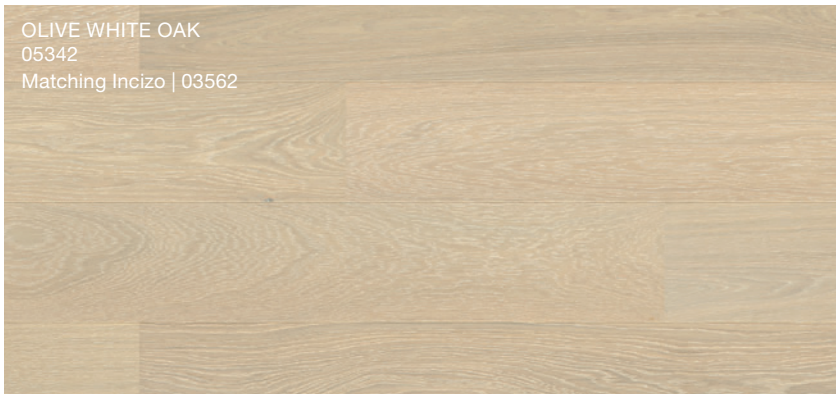

Pergo 5-in-1 offers different moulding solutions for different parts of your floor, all wrapped up in one handy package. The mouldings match your floor perfectly in colour, as well as in texture, and the one-piece solutions give a seamless installation result. The surface is made of wear and scratch-resistant veneer. The core consists of HDF and the bottom rail is made of plastic. With the patented Incizo® solution, you easily cut the moulding to the shape you need. Knife is included. Suitable for flooring heights between 12.5 and 14 mm.



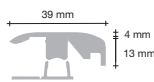

From wood to wood.



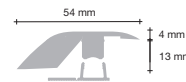
Carpet transition

From wood to carpet.



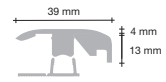
Hard surface reducer

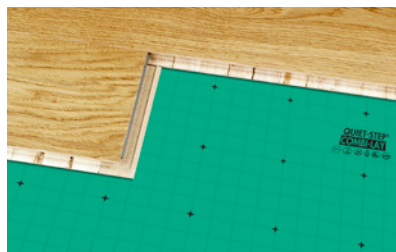


Combi-Lay Standard

Combi-Lay Standard is no normal underlay. The dense, closed cell polyolefin foam provides excellent support, with good reduction of both reflected and impact noise.



Quiet-Step Combi-Lay

QSC-LAY20FS; QSC-LAY50FS

20/50m² roll Thickness 2mm

Quiet-Step Combi-Lay is the first choice where a quiet step sound and maximum reduction in multi-storey noise is required. This high density underlay has no match when it comes to reducing foot fall noise, with a reduction of up to 30% over standard underlays.

Maintenance

Specially developed for cleaning laminate wood and vinyl flooring. Ideal for removing dirt, grease spots and heel marks, as well as for daily cleaning.



Repair wax
PGREPAIR

Repair the colour of damaged planks quickly and easily with wax in colours that match the Pergo wood palette. Contains 1 melting knife, 1 comb, 7 wax blocks. For more information on how to mix colours, please visit pergo.com.

In order to maintain the original texture and impression of your wood flooring it's important to clean and maintain it on a regular basis. After installation and before you furnish the room we suggest to clean the surface using a vacuum cleaner or a damp microfibre mop.

For the regular cleaning and maintenance, use dry – or damp – methods as much as possible using our microfibre mop with its large dirt holding capacity.

On occasion and based on the usage of the floor you can combine the damp microfibre with the Pergo Allround floor cleaner for the best result. It cleans the floor thoroughly, retains the original look of the floor, keeps the floor hygienic and does not cause layers of product to build up. Pergo Allround Cleaner is recommended no more than twice monthly

You should always control the amount of water used since a wooden material has limited resistance against water. A good rule of thumb when using water is to make sure that the surface is completely dry within 60 seconds.

Never use steel wool or another coarse material as this may damage the structure and appearance of the top layer. A Pergo wood floor may not be waxed or polished.

The top layer is sourced from sustainable supplies of oak and ash in Europe. Our lacquer meets strict international emission norms, so you can enjoy your wood flooring in the knowledge that it is made with respect for the environment.

As a testament to our commitment and care for the environment, Pergo was the first flooring company ever to receive the official Nordic Ecolabel, the Green Swan. And our new ecological and environmentally friendly wood floors are no exception!
